### Port Macquarie Pilot Cottages now the Maritime Museum

These three buildings are Pilot Station cottages. (A pilot was a person who guided ships in to shore by telling them the safest way.)

They are now part of the Mid North Coast Maritime Museum and were built between 1896 and 1937. There used to be four pilot cottages in this block. One was re-located to another part of Port Macquarie to make way for a new building on the site next door.

This site has been used for maritime activities from the earliest white settlement of Port Macquarie.

Located at 2,4,6 William Street Port Macquarie.
