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- Quarry Road** Rosewood. Runs south off the Oxley Highway in the Huntingdon area about 6km west of Wauchope.
- Quarry Way** Laurieton. The road leading to the quarry.
- Quartz Hill** At Frazer's Creek just outside Beechwood - well remembered for the scars of arsenic mines of the 1930s.
- Queens Head** A point 1km south of Point Plomer on the coast.
- Queens Lake** A perennial lagoon about 3km NNW of Laurieton. Recorded by John Oxley 13 Oct 1818 (see Place of Banishment p.28).

- Queens Lake** A parish (lands administrative division).  
Gazetted: 22 Dec 1972
- Queens Lake Road** The road leading to Queens Lake.  
(1) Located at Laurieton.  
(2) Another at Jolly Nose.
- Queens Lake State Forest** A state forest in the Taree forestry district area about 1137 hectares.  
Gazetted: 22 Dec 1972
- Quetta Island** An islet in Caswell Channel, West of Rawdon Island North, about 13km NW of the town of Port Macquarie.  
Gazetted: 6 Apr 1973
- Quintoc** Farm on Thone Creek road Thone River.
- Quintoc Ridge** A ridge starting just south of the Oxley Highway near Moripo Creek and extending south to finish approx. 1km NE of the junction of Thone River Road and Thone River.  
Gazetted: 20 Aug 2004
