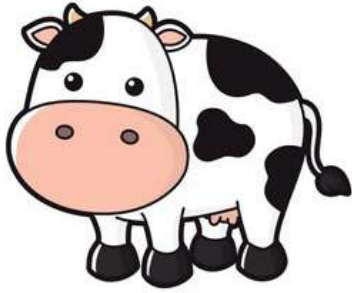


Up The Wooden Hill

Now there's eight fat sausages sizzling in a pan

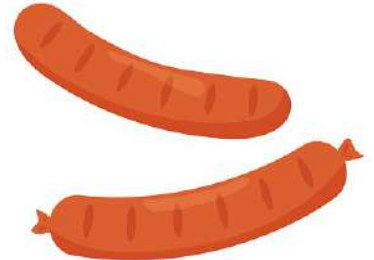
Eight fat sausages...
