





Re: Sq/Leader Fred Madsen. R.A.A.F. 1945.

This pilot, a DFC winner, was also known as "Masthead" Madsen, was in charge of 25 Australian Dakotas in Singapore in 1945. The planes were in Singapore for the rescue of P.O.W. in in accessible camps.

Two War Correspondents, A.E. (Eddie) Dunstan and Haydon Lennard, having heard the story of the Banka Island massacre and Sister Bullwinkel's survival from P.OW. in Changi, decided to get R.A.A.F. help to rescue Bullwinkel and other sisters as soon as possible.

They approached Madsen who made a plane available despite reported dangerous conditions for landing in Sumatra where the sisters were - somewhere. Madsen volunteered to fly the plane himself and take the two correspondents on their resurce flight. The project was kept secret, all correspondents agreeing to hold their despatches until the sisters were safe. They were believed to be in danger of reprisal, especially Bullwinkel, the only witness of the atrocious massacre.

In the ultimate Madsen could take only one correspondent (as well as medical personnel and crew) and it turned out to be Lennard. Maybe the reporters tossed a coin? Lennard flew with Madsen into Palembang, Sumatra on 14th Sept. 1945. Madsen had to return to Singapore with sick P.O.W. but returned on 15th Sept. with Dunatan on board, to find Lennard and the co-pilot had located the sick and sadly emaciated nurses who were flown to Singapore arriving by nightfall. The plane was full so Dunstan was obliged to remain in Sumatra where he helped (and reported on) the P.O.W. and internees, most of whom were in very poor condition.

I am writing newspaper features about the recovery of the nurses and would like to know if pilot Madsen's log or any of his reports are on record. I need only his notes of 14/15/16th February, 1945 - the re-occupation of Singapore.

Can you advise me please if there is any of this

material intact? I look forward to your reply ('phone or mail). Yours faithfully,



A DECORATION

For Sgt. Brian McConnell

Two members of a bomber crewthe pilot, Flying-Officer Wilbur David Parsons, of Beaconsfield, Tasmania, and the air-gunner, Sergeant Brian Alphonsus McConnell, of Coolangatta, Queensland, have been decorated for the great courage, skill, and determination they showed when their aircraft was attacked over Europe. Parsons has been awarded the DFC and McConnell the DFM.

In June, Parsons and McConnell were in an aircraft detailed to attack targe's in France. Enemy fighters attacked the bomber from close range. The port elevator was shot away, the trimming tabs were jammed, and the turret was made useless.

McConnell was wounded in bo'h hands and huried through his turret door, but he quickly re-entered the turret and, when new attacks developed, he gave such concise and welltimed directions .1hat Parsons was able to out-manoeuvre the attackers and fly the damaged bomber back to England.

Sgt. McConnell was formerly an employee of the H. D. Dairy Co., Ltd., Telegraph, from whence he enlisted in the RAAF, and is wellknown in Port Macquarie.

Word has been received that Pilot Officer Brian McConnell, RAAF, was killed over England on 6th January in air operations. This young airman, who before joining up was employed by the H. D. Dairy Co-op. Co., Ltd., Telegraph Point, was awarded the D.F.M. last year. He was made a Pilot Officer following receipt of this decoration, and has since had added to the decoration two silver stars for meritorious service. Brian was well known in the Hastings District as a player in the Telegraph Point cricket team, and many will regret his passing. With others he has given his all for his country - no man can do more.


