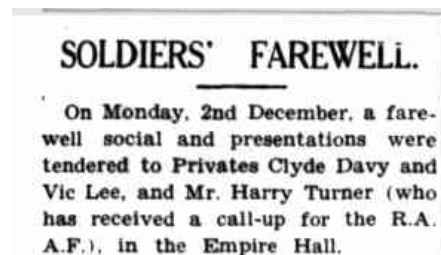
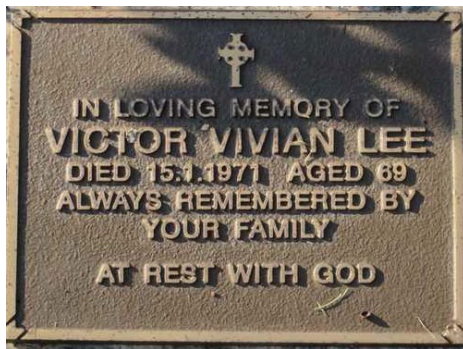

**PTE. E. G. LEWIS**

The very sad news was conveyed to his parents on Tuesday that Private Eric George Lewis had been killed in action at Balikpapan, Borneo, last week, whilst fighting with the 7th Australian Division. Official notification was received by his wife in Sydney that morning.

Pte. Lewis was born at Port Macquarie, being the youngest son of Mr. and Mrs. J. G. Lewis, Clarence Street, Port Macquarie, and was 22 years of age last month. He enlisted in the A.I.F., and saw service in New Guinea, going away three years ago in June. He was wounded in action in that theatre of war last year, and was one of the local boys who had been extended a welcome home by the Women's Comforts Fund.

Besides his sorrowing parents, the deceased soldier leaves a young wife and an eighteen months' old son to mourn their loss.

All will join in sympathy with the relatives in their time of sorrow, and respect and revere the memory of such a young soldier, who has given his all—life—in such a noble cause. May the sacrifice of this and other lads not have been in vain, and may their lives and actions ever remain green in our memory.

Three other brothers served their country in the R.A.A.F. Lac. Harry Lewis (Darwin), and Cpl. Darcy Lewis (Queensland), whilst Lac. Des. Lewis was discharged, medically unfit, from the Air Force several weeks ago.—Post "News."

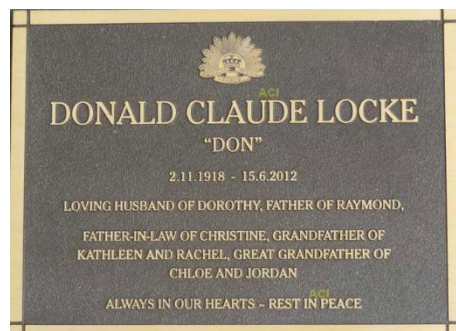

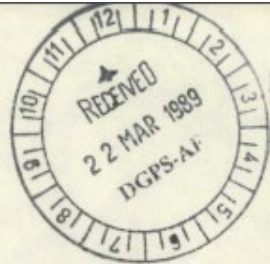

Re: Sq/Leader Fred Madsen. R.A.A.F. 1945.

This pilot, a DFC winner, ~~was~~ also known as "Masthead" Madsen, was in charge of 25 Australian Dakotas in Singapore in 1945. The planes were in Singapore for the rescue of P.O.W. in inaccessible camps.

Two War Correspondents, A.E. (Eddie) Dunstan and Haydon Lennard, having heard the story of the Banka Island massacre and Sister Bullwinkel's survival from P.O.W. in Changi, decided to get R.A.A.F. help to rescue Bullwinkel and other sisters as soon as possible.

They approached Madsen who made a plane available despite reported dangerous conditions for landing in Sumatra where the sisters were - somewhere. Madsen volunteered to fly the plane himself and take the two correspondents on their rescue flight. The project was kept secret, all correspondents agreeing to hold their despatches until the sisters were safe. They were believed to be in danger of reprisal, especially Bullwinkel, the only witness of the atrocious massacre.

In the ultimate Madsen could take only one correspondent (as well as medical personnel and crew) and it turned out to be Lennard. Maybe the reporters tossed a coin? Lennard flew with Madsen into Palembang, Sumatra on 14th Sept. 1945. Madsen had to return to Singapore with sick P.O.W. but returned on 15th Sept. with Dunstan on board, to find Lennard and the co-pilot had located the sick and sadly emaciated nurses who were flown to Singapore arriving by nightfall. The plane was full so Dunstan was obliged to remain in Sumatra where he helped (and reported on) the P.O.W. and internees, most of whom were in very poor condition.

I am writing newspaper features about the recovery of the nurses and would like to know if pilot Madsen's log or any of his reports are on record. I need only his notes of 14/15/16th February, 1945 - the re-occupation of Singapore.

Can you advise me please if there is any of this material intact? I look forward to your reply ('phone or mail).
